

COUNTRY PARK

The Sandringham Estate, including the six hundred acres of the Country Park, lies within the Norfolk Coast Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Do allow enough time during your visit to Sandringham to walk in this beautiful woodland; there are two nature trails (2 miles and 3 miles approximately) and many other tree-lined paths, with plenty of places to picnic and a children's play area.

The Country Park is open every day of the year; there is no charge and the parking is free.
